

TOWING CHECKLIST

The following information is provided to assist caravan owners in checking and securing their trailer prior to, and after travel. It is not definitive and should be used as a guide only. You should regularly assess your specific travel needs and create your own checklist based on your personal circumstances.

- **Check that the hitch is tight, the chains are connected, and that the caravan lights and break controller are connected and the lights are working properly.**
- **Regularly check the caravan's bearings, brakes and tyres for excessive heat by feeling them. This check can be done when stopping for lunch or at a fuel stop.**

Use a towing tips checklist to ensure the trailer is right to travel and you haven't forgotten anything. An example checklist is given below:

- Trailer hitch properly connected
- Safety chains properly connected
- Trailer lights plugged in
- Break controller connected
- Gas bottles turned off
- All cupboards in cabin and kitchen closed and locked
- Auxiliary battery charger on
- Windows, doors and rooftop fan closed and locked
- Front box and rear kitchen doors closed and locked
- Hot water shower stored away (if applicable)
- Door steps stored away (if applicable)
- Roof top tent packed away (if applicable)
- Stabilising jacks wound up
- Jockey wheel up
- Trailer handbrake dis-engaged
- Check tyre pressure (including spare)

BE SURE TO RE-CHECK ITEMS THAT YOU HAVE USED AT ANY LUNCH STOPS
